- Biologic half life of ketamine is 45 minutes in the horse, with 99% of a bolus dose eliminated in 4 hours

ID-182: Wobbler Syndrome in Horses

walks the horse away while the other person grabs the tail and pulls the horse to one side A normal horse will allow that to happen once before rapidly correcting itself However, a horse exhibiting wobbler syndrome cannot tell where its limbs are, especially the hind limbs, thus you can easily pull the horse over to one side
