The “Craftsman style” Bungalow design was spread rapidly across the country by architects, builders and designers in the early part of the 20th century. The Craftsman style developed fully out of the work of Gustav Stickley, publisher of The Craftsman magazine (1903-1933), and Henry H. Saylor, author of Bungalows (1911). Craftsman homes are often 1 to 1 ½ stories, making dormers – windows that project outward from a sloping roof – very common. While other home styles also utilize dormers, in Craftsman homes, they’re typically centered on the roof and add an extra dimension of height to the homes.
