which means that they contain 1, 3, 5 AND 7 (as well as variations of these chord tones). In its most basic form, this simply means that we take the 1st note, 3rd note, 5th note, AND 7th note of the Major scale, to produce what's called the Major 7 chord.

Jazz chords are shapes that use at least 4 notes in their construction. These are chords that go beyond the 3-note triad and include the 7th, 9th, 11th, and/or 13th. If you want to play a major chord in rock, you would normally just play the major triad, G for example.
